A scheduling conference was conducted on June 17, 2025, with Hearing Officer Scott Zanzig; Michael Christian, counsel for Snake River Oil and Gas; Kayleen Richter representing Idaho Department of Lands (“IDL”); and James Thum, IDL Program Manager, Oil and Gas, attending.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following deadlines and procedures will govern this matter going forward:

1. On or before **July 3, 2025**, the parties will file the following with the Hearing Officer and serve copies on opposing counsel:

a. A disclosure of witnesses by name, address, and telephone number who will testify at the evidentiary hearing in this matter, including expert witnesses, along with a summary of the anticipated testimony of each witness;

b. An exhibit list;

c. The parties shall provide a copy of their proposed exhibits to one another and the Hearing Officer (Applicant Snake River Oil and Gas shall number its exhibits as follows: “SR-01,” “SR-02,” “SR-03,” etc.; IDL shall number its exhibits as follows: “IDL-01,” “IDL-02,” “IDL-03,” etc.; and

d. A prehearing statement.

SCHEDULING ORDER

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2. The in-person evidentiary hearing in this matter is scheduled on **July 10, 2025, and will be held at Fruitland City Hall Council Chamber, located at 200 S. Whitley, Fruitland Idaho, 83619.** The evidentiary portion of the hearing will commence at 1:00 p.m. Mountain Time and conclude at 5:00 p.m. The hearing will be open for public comment beginning at 5:00 p.m. Mountain Time and will conclude no later than 7:00 p.m.

3. A Zoom link will be available for remote participation.

4. A prehearing status conference will be held **July 7, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. Mountain Time.** A Zoom link for that conference will be sent contemporaneously with this order. The purpose of this conference is to discuss all prehearing matters, including objections, stipulations, narrowing of issues, burden of proof, and any other preliminary matters that need to be addressed prior to the hearing.

5. To “file” and “serve” their documents, the parties may email them to all other parties at the addresses listed in the attached Certificate of Service before any deadline, with a copy to scott.zanzig@oah.idaho.gov and filings@oah.idaho.gov.

6. The Hearing Officer will arrange for a court reporter. The cost of the court reporter appearance fee will be borne by the Idaho Department of Lands. If any party or participant requests a copy of the transcript, that party or participant will bear the cost of such transcript. If all parties request a copy of the transcript, the cost of a transcript will be borne equally by the parties. If the Hearing Officer requests a copy of the transcript, the cost of the transcript will be borne equally by the parties. In addition, the hearing will be recorded via Zoom or some other recording device.

7. Should any party or counsel require special accommodations pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, they must notify the Hearing Officer of such request on or before

July 7, 2025, at the prehearing status conference.
