We have lived in the Treasure Valley all of our lives. We live just a half a mile from the Barlow section and a half mile from the Fallon section.

The oil and gas industry has been in Payette County for years, yet we have never seen advertising for jobs in our local papers. We disagree that “local” folks have been working and benefiting from this industry. We have talked to employees working at the well sites and the pipeline. We see their out of state license plates and hear their Texas accent, as they share with us, they don’t live here.

While the law promises ONE well per spacing unit, this company’s intent appears to put as many holes in the ground as they can, *all along the banks of the Payette River*.

What we want for us, our family and community, is to continue living here without profound risks to our water, property, and quality of life.

We oppose the drilling of a second well in the Barlow section, but since the commission has granted SROG’s appeal to do so, *we strongly support the requirement of a new integration order*, so property and royalty owners are given the opportunity to have input.
