My name is Holly Fugate. My husband, Adam Fugate, and I own a home at 2725 Dogwood Avenue in Fruitland, Idaho. We have owned our home for a little over two years and have just been made aware of the Fallen well drilled near our neighborhood to the south. I write this email to you, the Idaho Department of Lands, to express our concern about Alta Mesa's application to utilize this well that has been (alarmingly) already drilled.

In no uncertain terms we do not support Alta Mesa or any oil and gas company's drilling of any well so close to our neighborhood (or any neighborhood for that matter). We are very concerned about our property rights and the possibility of the value of our home going down due to this well being utilized. Not only that, but the possible damage to our property, properties around us, health concerns due to pollution to our air and water in such close proximity to our house.

We planned to raise our 4 children and our small dog in this idyllic little neighborhood tucked away in The Treasure Valley. It is surprising to us that Idaho, such a family friendly state, would allow such a well to be drilled so close to a river, a water treatment center and to families with small children and retirees, the most vulnerable citizens.

We beg you not to allow this well to go into to use for the sake of our family and all the other families in our neighborhood and town.
