The Department has received the Monthly Production & Disposition Report for January 2018 for wells operated by Alta Mesa Services, LP in the state of Idaho. This report indicates no production for the ML Investments #1-10 well, USWN 11-075-20007. According to production reports submitted to the Department by Alta Mesa since 2016, this well has had no reported production volumes since January 2016.


Per IDAPA 20.07.02.501.01 the "Department shall declare a well inactive after twenty-four (24) continuous months of inactivity if the owner or operator has not received approval for active status, ..." Further, IDAPA 20.07.02.501.02 states that "an owner or operator must plug and abandon an inactive well in accordance with Section 502 of these rules within six (6) months of being notified by the Department unless the owner or operator supplies the following information within the six-month time period:

- a. A written request to extend inactive status;
- b. An individual bond, as provided for in Subsection 220.03 of these rules, if the well was covered by a blanket bond; and
- c. A description of how the well is closed to the atmosphere with a swedge and valve, packer or other approved method, and how the well is to be maintained."

This letter serves as official notice of the Department's declaration of inactive status as provided for in IDAPA 20.07.02.501. Please provide the above requested information to the Department at your earliest convenience for our review of the status of this well.
