I'm very concerned, even distressed, to hear that SROG has filed for a permit to drill yet another gas/oil well identified as Barlow #2-14. This site is dangerously close to the banks and in the floodplain of the Payette River, a mere 20 feet from the Barlow #1-14 well which was drilled there by Alta Mesa in 2018. These wells present a potential danger to the Fruitland city water supply as they are just upstream from the city's water intake plant. They also pose a threat to nearby homes and farms, as well as wildlife and livestock living in or near the river. I strongly state, please, do not approve this permit. The potential problems to the people of Payette and their water source is a resource we need to protect.
