Comment:

I am writing to request that you deny the application from Snake River Oil and Gas, LLC, to drill a second well (Barlow #2-14) on the banks of the Payette River. The chance for contamination of the river, local domestic water wells and the drinking water of Fruitland community is too great. Current bond requirements are not adequate to address an issue should it arise. Any leak or spill would have a profound effect on the wildlife and livestock in the area and is the contamination is likely to last well into the future. Oil and gas wells do not belong on the banks of any Idaho river. We need to protect our water sources for generations to come. It is a precious resource especially as we face greater likelihood of drought. Clean water is more precious to Idahoans than any profits that could be derived from this proposed well.
