

## Negotiated Rulemaking Meeting Notes – April 11, 2024

Name of Negotiated Rulemaking: IDAPA 20.07.02, Rules Governing Conservation of Oil and Natural

Gas in the State of Idaho **Docket number:** 20-0702-2401

This meeting is the first of three scheduled negotiated rulemaking meetings. James Thum presented an overview of the rulemaking process and reviewed the draft rule changes.

**Discussion:** James Thum started the meeting with a brief introduction, followed by a presentation of the meeting format and guidelines for participation. The presentation described the Executive Order for Zero Based Regulation, the Negotiated Rulemaking process, a brief summary of the major revisions being proposed in draft #1 and the rulemaking timeline. Mr. Thum then presented the first draft of the Rule revisions.

A comment was received on IDAPA 20.07.02.200.05 concerning the deletion of the reasons for denial of a permit to drill, deepen, or plug back an oil and gas well. The commentor suggested that deleting this section created a concern that removing them may make the reasons more discretionary, lead to non-enforcement, or that there might be a question regarding the reason for a denial at a later date if not specified in the Rule.

A comment was received on IDAPA 20.07.02.210.03 similar to the above comment concerning the deletion of the reasons for denial of a permit to treat an oil and gas well. The commentor suggested that deleting this section created a concern that removing them may make the reasons more discretionary, lead to non-enforcement, or that there might be a question regarding the reason for a denial at a later date if not specified in the Rule.

Following the presentation of draft #1, Mr. Thum requested that participants contact the Department through the Comments portal or via direct email if there were additional suggestions or recommendations not submitted verbally during today's Negotiated Rulemaking session.
