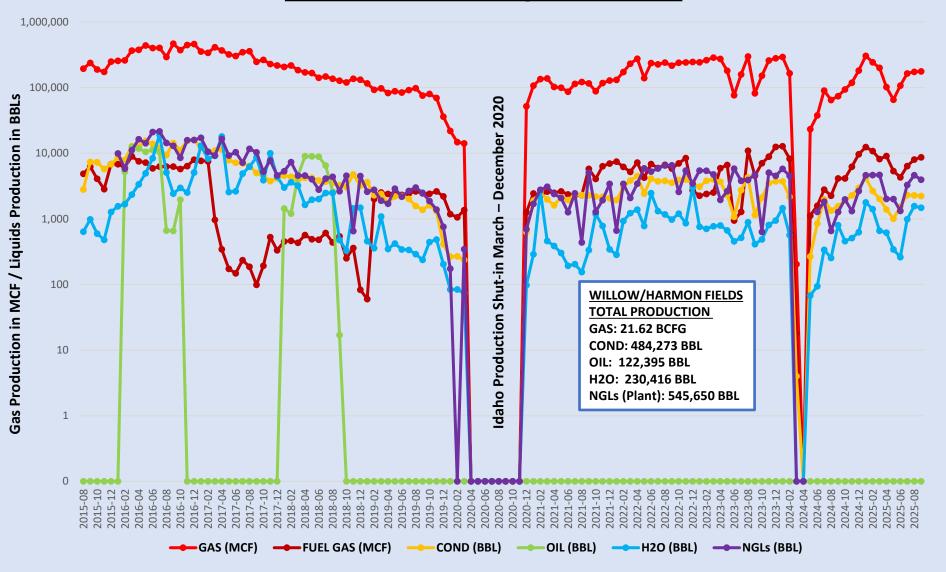

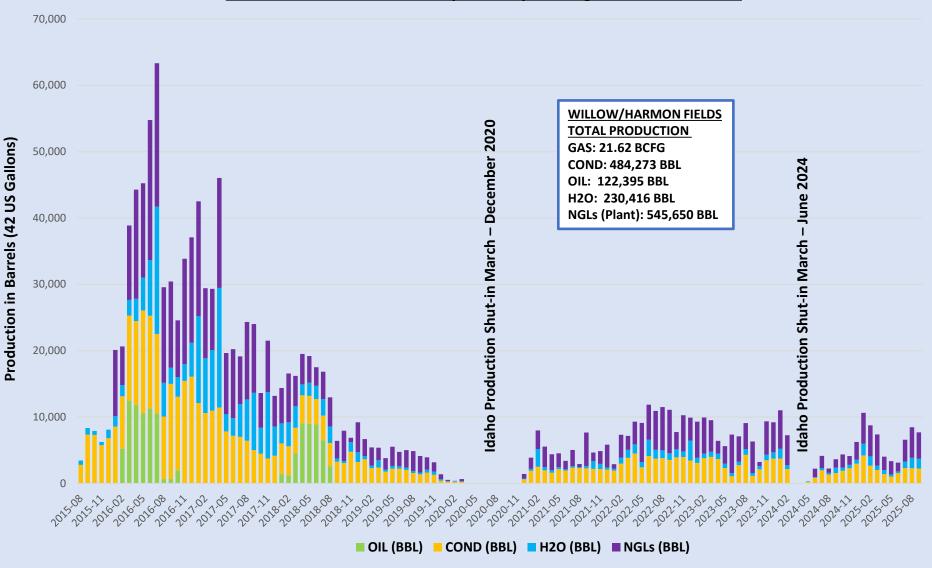

#### Western Idaho Production - August 2015 to Present



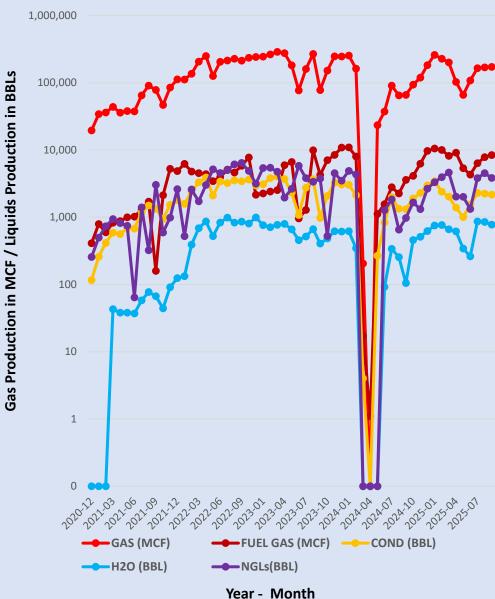

### OIL AND GAS WELLS — GEOLOGIC INFORMATION, AND PREVENTION OF WASTE
