Dear Mr. Thum,

I am writing to formally object to the James #1-10 permit application for the following reasons:

Proximity Hazard: My own investigation confirms that the proposed well site is located approximately 100 feet from my property boundary/water assets. This is within the standard safety setbacks and poses an immediate risk to my residential safety and geological integrity.

Mitigation Asset: I have officially initiated the Section 401 Water Quality Certification with the DEQ. My 5.24-acre property is a designated environmental asset.

Baseline Requirement: Due to the extreme proximity (100 ft), I demand a mandatory, operator-funded baseline water and soil test before any site preparation begins.

Correlative Rights: I have not received a formal election form for my 5.24 net mineral acres. I demand the \$150/acre bonus and 12.5% royalty be secured.

Please stay the issuance of this permit until a site inspection can verify these distances. Furthermore, I am asserting that the proposed well location violates Idaho Code § 47-319, as it sits approximately 100 feet from my property line and assets. I have not provided the express written consent required to waive the mandatory 300-foot setback. I demand an immediate site survey to verify these distances before this permit is considered."
