Dear James,

My name is Shawna Pierson and I have been a proud Fruitland resident for over 60 years. I appreciate the opportunity to provide comments in regards to the Application for Permit to Drill for the Miller #1-15 submitted by Snake River Oil & Gas.

I would request that you deny The Application to Drill. This particular well sits in the heart of the City of Fruitland and is currently closely surrounded on three sides in city limits. Additionally, this particular well is only 118 ft from the nearest property line ( See Exhibit Map of Miller 1-15 submitted in applications). This is way too close to dozens of residential structures.

There are several locations around the City of Fruitland that would be better suited to place a gas well. It makes no sense to drill so close to residential housing and irrigation ditches. By drilling that close to residents there is a chance to cause irreversible harm to the people of Fruitland. The Applicants are not concerned about the impact this will cause on the residents of Fruitland and surrounding towns.

Therefore, I respectfully request that The Idaho Department of Lands deny the application to drill located on Parcel 08N05W159161.
