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Petroleum Exploration & Development in Idaho General Process

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This guidance document is not a new law. This document is an interpretation of existing law, except as authorized by Idaho Code or incorporated into a contract.

Purpose

This flowchart is designed to show the general framework for an operator to begin hydrocarbon exploration and production in Idaho. It shows many necessary applications, permits, reporting requirements, and the order of steps to obtain them. The guidelines provided may not include every step that may be necessary for an operator's specific circumstances, and a person should review the Oil and Gas Act (Title 47, chapter 3, Idaho Code) and Rules Governing Conservation of Oil and Natural Gas in the State of Idaho (IDAPA 20.07.02) for additional steps that might apply to an operator's situation.

Seismic Exploration (optional procedure)

- 1. Application for Seismic Permit (IDAPA 20.07.02.100) and Bond (IDAPA 20.07.02.100.03)
- 2. Sundry Notice to Commence Operations (IDAPA 20.07.02.030)
- 3. Seismic Survey Operations

Drilling and Well Construction



- 3. Well Plugging Operations
- 4. Final Well Plugging Report (IDAPA 20.07.02.502), Abandonment & Reclamation within 30 days of completion of operations (IDAPA 20.07.02.510)
