Mr. Thomas

We live in Fruitland in the subdivision directly south of the proposed spacing. We presently still own our mineral interest and object to the approval of spacing order. We are retired and are concern about the health issues related to a gas well. Namely air and water quality, impacts to the Payette River and degradation of the community.

We have the following question that should be answered at the Payette hearing:

- What is the relationship between AM Idaho and High Mesa Holdings and Weiser Brown?
- Can this spacing order be extended without a public process?
- Will directional boring be allowed?
 - If so, will the boring extend south of the spacing?
- Will fracking be allowed?
 - If so, what impacts will we have? We hear that there could be noisy, smells and causes vibrations from fracking is this true?
- Will gas be released and/or burned?
 - If so, what gasses would be exposed to the environment?
 - Why can't these gasses be captured and sold?
- We have heard that other sites in the Fruitland area are being or have been explored for gas. Is this true?
 - If so, where and will we be impacted?
- We hear that a pipeline will be installed to the gas field in the Willow Creek. Is this correct?
 - If not, what will be the impact to the traffic on highway 95?
- In the past you had trouble collecting the revenues from Alta Mesa. What are you doing to improve and prevent this from happening again?

We lived in Colorado before moving to Fruitland and watched the gas and oil field develop over the years. There where a lot of mistakes made by both the communities and developers. Why can't Idaho learn form states like Colorado and implement the regulations that would make gas development more palatable to the communities reducing large legal issues?
