Dear Neighbor,

By now you have received the packet from the Idaho Department of Lands, (IDL) requesting your comments on an important hearing that will directly impact you, regarding Alta Mesa's (part of a group of Texas oil companies, many of which are already bankrupt) application for a gas/oil well which has already been drilled in your vicinity. For those who do not know, the Fallon well is next to Highway 95, only 100 yards south of the Payette River, and only 1000 feet from Fruitland's Water Plant.

**Please know YOUR HOME is in the targeted area.**

**It is critical that you respond, even if you have NOT signed a lease with any oil companies.**

I live less than ¼ mile east of Hwy 95 and I am not in the targeted 610 acres. As a result, I do not get to step up and write a letter. However, in September 2017, I received an envelope from IDL. More than 30 neighbors in my section wrote letters and we were SUCCESSFUL in halting the force pooling application! Please know, your letter makes a difference.

It is so important for everyone in the area of impact to respond.

**THIS IS YOUR CHANCE TO HAVE YOUR VOICES HEARD!**

**This well has the very real potential to impact your property values, your water, your air quality, the surrounding landscape, and your way of life.**

**You should have a say in what happens to your property rights!**

**Letters and emails must be received no later than January 29, 2020 in order to be considered.**

Don't know what to say? Tell the Idaho Department of Lands that you **WANT**:

- Your property values to be free from jeopardy - values typically drop 2-13% in areas where drilling is occurring, and up to 75% when the water is contaminated
- Your water supplies free of contamination
- Your family's health free from any health risks
- The Payette River and your air quality environmentally safe

And we expect them to do their jobs and **PROTECT PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS!**

**IF** everyone stands together, only then can we protect our property, and our families. If we do nothing, we give Alta Mesa permission to do what they want, and IDL will rubber stamp their application. **WE MUST SPEAK UP NOW!**


