Dear Mr. Morris:

On May 23rd and May 24th, we had a crew at the site. The purpose was to make any needed repairs to the fencing and move the straw bales away from the fence. The fence repair has been completed and all bails except six were moved. There was a lot of rain while working there which prevented moving those last bails. As soon as it dries sufficiently we will return and finish cleaning up the area. Enclosed is a picture of the site.

We are in the planning process of determining whether an addition well will be drilled from that pad location. If we do drill another well CPC will per paragraph 3. V. of our agreement compensation you for this new well to be paid at the beginning of drilling.

In the event we do not drill another well the site will be restored per the terms of paragraph 6 of our agreement. As soon as we have the answer I will let you know.
